

## PARISH COUNCIL OF BOTTISHAM – BURIAL GROUND

These are the tables of fees, payments and sums fixed and settled under the Local Authorities Cemetery Order 1974, by resolution of Bottisham Parish Council, acting as the Burial Authority for the said parish dated 9<sup>th</sup> April 2026.

The fees, payments and sums set out below apply where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is, or before his death was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Bottisham or, in the case of a stillborn child, where the parents or one of them is, or at the time of the interment, were such inhabitants or parishioners. If a parishioner or inhabitant has had to move out of the village for medical care, or to a nursing home or residential home due to no fault of their own, then residential rates would apply. The Parish Council will not accept burials from out of area, except in the case when burial rights have already been purchased.

The fee for transferring grave ownership between parties will be £50 in all cases. All graves and cremation plots must be left level after allowing reasonable time to settle.

### Part One: Interment

The fees do not include the digging of the grave.

For any interment in a grave	Of the body of a stillborn child, or of a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed one month	<b>£0</b>
	Of the body of a child whose age at the time of death exceeded one month but not twelve years	<b>£0</b>
	Of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded twelve years	<b>£200</b>
For the interment of <b>cremated</b> remains in a grave		<b>£100</b>

In the event that the below *Exclusive Right of Burial in Earthen Grave* is not purchased, no memorial may be erected, and the plot may be re-used after a period of 75 years.

### **Part Two: Exclusive Right of Burial in Earthen Grave**

The fees indicated below entitle the purchaser to exclusive burial in a grave for a period not exceeding 75 years.

For the Exclusive Right of Burial for a period <b>not</b> exceeding 75 years	Of a body in an earthen grave 6 feet by 3 feet (1.8m x 900mm) to be specified single or double depth.	<b>£200</b>
	Of <b>cremated</b> remains in an earthen grave 2 feet by 2 feet to be specified single or double depth.	<b>£100</b>

The fees indicated in Part Two above include the Deed of Grant and the expenses thereof.

### **Part Three: Monuments, Gravestones, Tablets and Monumental Inscriptions**

A monument may only be placed on a grave where an Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted. Memorials may only be erected after a period of nine months from the date of burial. Headstones, plaques and tablets are permitted within the cemetery. However, kerb edging, loose stones, artificial shrubbery and lighting are not permitted due to health and safety considerations. Memorials must not exceed 4 feet in height and should be in keeping with others within the cemetery. A permit must be obtained from the Parish Council prior to any stonemasonry work being carried out.

A headstone not exceeding 4 feet in height	<b>£130</b>
Each subsequent inscription after the first initial inscription on either headstone or plaque	<b>£100</b>
