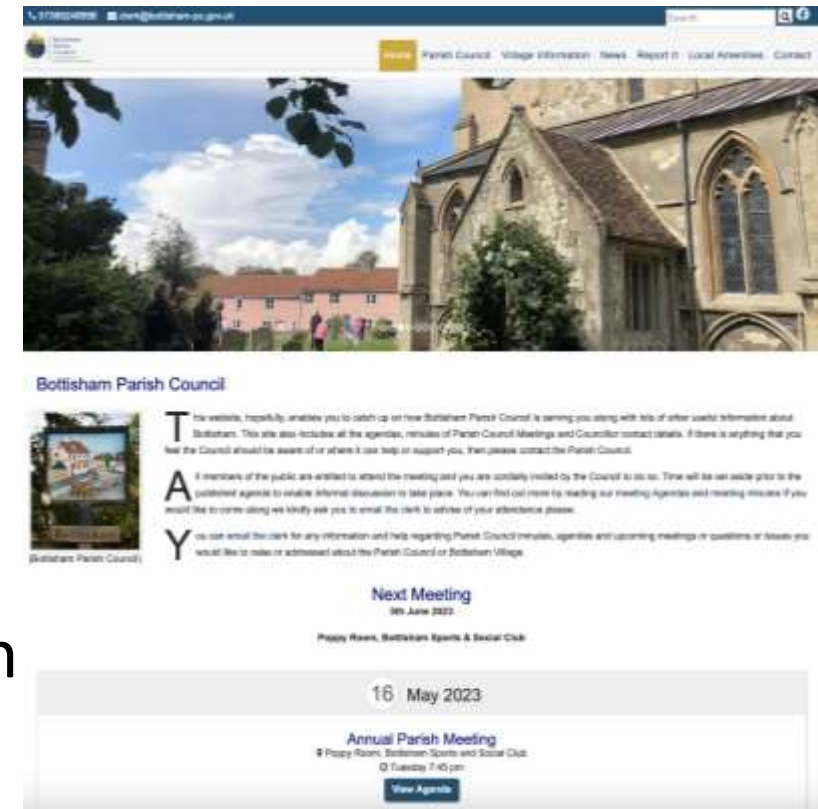

New Cemetery

- Current cemetery nearing capacity
- Residents survey showed site wanted in Bottisham
- Site chosen off Lode Road
- ECDC compulsory purchase from National Trust
- Completed land and soil surveys
- June 2023 – search & appoint build contractors
- Planned completion 2025

Project Playground

- Residents Want & Need better playground provisions
- Challenge: Parish Council owns no land
- Number of residents consultations carried out to no avail
- Council allocated monies for 2023/24 to purchase land
- Volunteers working group set up - welcome more people
- Project Play inaugural meeting – Monday 12th June
- Speak with Parish Council working group tonight



Neighbourhood Plan – In Development Stage

- A group of Parish Councillors & volunteers are creating a Bottisham Neighbourhood Plan
- This will set out planning policies for our neighbourhood area
- Policies are used to decide whether to approve planning applications
- Establish a vision for Bottishams' future & have your say on what new buildings should look like
- Once adopted it has legal standing in planning terms
- Regular meetings currently being held
- Speak with Parish Council tonight



Bottisham Greenways

- 2 out of 12 proposed Greenways aim to make local walking & cycling journeys easier.
- Bottisham Greenway will be 5.9 miles long.
- Starts in Bottisham and proceeds along A1303.
- Dedicated cycle pathway down Bell Road & outside shops & Lode Road
- Parish Council asking GCP to consult with residents

Bottisham Greenway

Bell Road

Challenges & Opportunities:

- Physical constraints (i.e. trees and overhead utilities)
- Proximity to pumping station

Proposal:

- Widening of existing shared use path to 3m where applicable
- Buildout to allow safe transition for cyclists on/off carriageway
- Reduction from National Speed Limit to 40mph on approach to Newmarket Road
- Quiet street environment from buildout into Bottisham

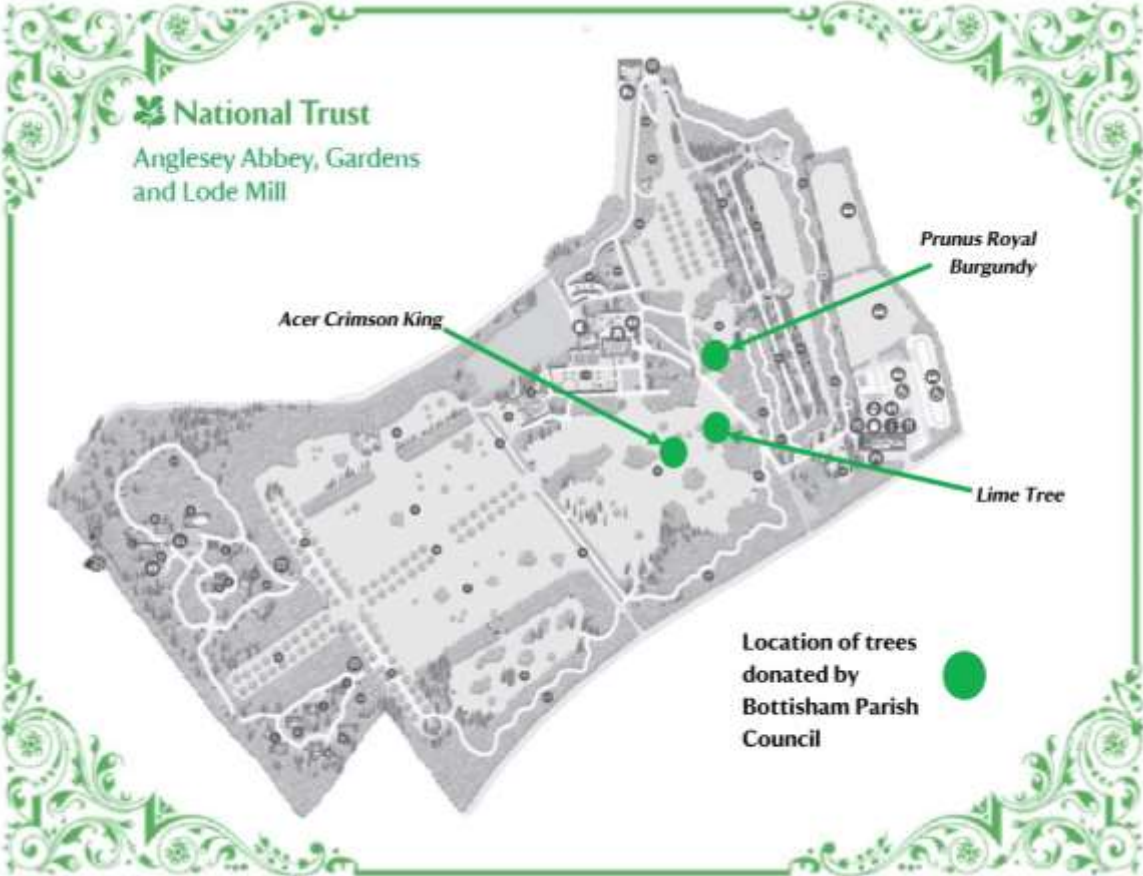




Bottisham is Celebrating The Kings Coronation - Sunday 7th May

Acer Crimson King *Prunus Royal Burgundy* *Lime Tree*

To celebrate and commemorate the coronation of King Charles III on 6th May 2023 Bottisham Parish Council have donated a beautiful purple maple tree aptly named 'The Crimson King'. This is a fitting tribute to our new monarch, a champion for the environment, to celebrate the first year of his reign and leave a lasting legacy for future generations to enjoy.

As part of the National Queen's Green Canopy campaign, to commemorate The Queen's Platinum Jubilee 2022 and honour Her Majesty's reign Bottisham Parish Council has donated a Limetree Tilia and Japanese Flowering Cherry also known as a "Prunus Royal Burgundy". These trees will serve as a reminder to all visitors here at Anglesey Abbey of Her Late Majesty's strength, longevity and stability that underpinned her reign. These trees demonstrate true nature, beauty, history, for everyone, for ever and we hope you enjoy your walk around these beautiful gardens.
