

Cambridgeshire County Council is proposing to lower the speed limit within our village to 20mph & to implement 40mph buffer zones on approach roads.

The proposals are part of a wider programme at the county council to introduce more 20mph speed limits across the county.

This application, supported by Bottisham Parish Council, is in response to your concerns & requests.

The reason this is needed within the village is it will help address significant known safety issues that have got progressively worse over a number of years.

Our village roads are full of fast-moving cars, vans & lorries - making our roads & footpaths unsafe for pedestrians, cyclists & more.

Children, older people & those with mobility issues are particularly at risk.

The 20mph speed limit would be across the entire village.

Whilst our village has been prioritised for this scheme, further work on the proposals & public consultation will take place before any work takes place.
